We have loved our two Literacy texts this term; firstly Shackleton, where we became Antarctic explorers. We learned so much about the expedition and conditions at the Pole. We were then able to use Wick Waves radio station to record our own broadcast. We took on different roles and carried out an interview with different crew members - we loved broadcasting. Leaf was a new text which led to us writing an instruction guide for how to make a refugee welcome at school - this was useful to think about school life from someone else's perspective.
