In maths, we have got really stuck into multiplication. We been investigating have different ways of multiplying large numbers, with Mr Ward and Mrs Lyndon-Jones challenging us to find more than 2 ways of solving different problems. We have had a focus on long multiplication. We are applying the multiplication skills we have learned to different problems. We have been multiplying 2 3 and even 4 digit numbers!
